## Vicksburg Meal Site Closes; Lunch & Learn Cancelled

Due to the ongoing low attendance at the Vicksburg Community Center's (VCC) senior citizens' meal site, Senior Services will cease serving meals at the VCC in February. **The final meal day in Vicksburg will be Thursday, February 12.** The monthly Lunch & Learn Series also will cease due to the closure of the meal site. There will be no Lunch & Learn in February.

**The Senior Services meal site at the Schoolcraft Community Center will continue operations as usual.** Meals are served there Monday—Thursday at noon. Call 679-5563 by 11 AM on the day prior to order a meal at the Schoolcraft site. Meals are \$2.50 for persons age 60 and over; \$4 for those under 60.

**Y**ou may be noticing some small changes in our newsletter – and may have noticed that the *Senior Sampler* has now become the *South County Sampler*. Changes are happening here and our intention is to make this newsletter for the entire population of South County!

This is an endeavor that Senior Programs Coordinator Terri Franklin has been diligently working on. We are shaking things up a bit and moving forward, so we hope that you like the new and improved look and feel. **The subscription fee is being dropped** – but, we still have to pay the bill, so we will ask that you consider donating to the newsletter cause.

Ensuring that residents know what services are available is a top priority, so our changes will be gradual but continual. Please contact the agency if you know of anyone who could benefit from being added to our mailing list.

The holidays were full of wrapping, shopping, organizing and laughter (yes, and some new gray hair)! This was my first year at SCCS during the holidays, and WOW! it was amazing. As a small staff – 3 full time and one ½ time – we truly rely on our devoted volunteers to help with our programming. This year we facilitated over 300 holiday baskets, 75 adopted Christmas families, and approximately 300 children who were able to visit Santa and Mrs. Claus at the holiday party, receive gifts, games, hats and mittens. Without the donations of the community, we would not have been able to provide these gifts to our income-qualifying residents.

We also thank those wonderful businesses and service clubs, church members and individual volunteers for filling in the gaps, taking my frantic phone calls for help, and providing the “person power” that we four girls couldn’t do alone. These are amazing communities in which we live and work, and the many families that struggled through this Christmas have called and expressed their sincere appreciation for what you have done.

As extraordinary times continue to befall us, it is likely that the agency will see the need for our community members to continue to work together to get **everyone** through these tough times. Our food pantry continues to see many more families who have to come for the first time, thinking that this would not happen to their families. Please consider the families in need in our communities when you are shopping and find a sale on healthy food or personal care items for the pantry, or when you are wondering what to do with your excess garden produce this summer.

As I have met members of the community, I have noticed that many are unaware of the services South County Community Services provides, and know little about the agency functions. We ask that you help spread the word!!!! Page 5 of this Sampler has a summary of services for you.

## Do you know about all the programs available through South County Community Services?

If you, or someone you know could benefit from our programs, please call us! 269-649-2901. We're here to help!!

**Emergency Food Assistance:** A four-day supply of food for income-qualifying individuals and families. Toiletries, personal care items and cleaning products also are provided if we have supplies available.

**Financial Assistance:** Limited financial aid is available for assistance with shut-off notices, evictions, and prescriptions. SCCS works with other agencies, churches and organizations to provide relief to residents. You must qualify through proof of income and address.

**Back to School Bonanza:** This August program is made possible through a partnership with Generous Hands, Inc. Qualifying children receive school supplies, backpacks and a variety of items which help prepare them for a new school year.

**Senior Programming:** Trips, exercise, Tai Chi, social gatherings, Senior Services meal sites, foot clinics, flu shot clinics, education, and a variety of other programs for our community seniors.

**Program for Adults with Disabilities (PAD):** Disabled adults have weekly social gatherings which include lunch and activities. The group is facilitated by a staff person and local volunteers. Shopping and field trips are often a part of the fun.

**Holiday Programs:** In 2008 approximately 300 holiday food baskets were distributed to our Income- and residential-qualifying families. Christmas is made special with a holiday party where children receive gifts, hats, mittens and a special visit with Santa and Mrs. Claus.

**IF YOU EAT,  
YOU QUALIFY!!**

**A**ngel Food Ministries is a non-profit, non-denominational organization dedicated to providing food assistance to individuals and families. What started in 1994 with one church and 34 families in Monroe, Georgia, has grown to serve hundreds of thousands of families in 35 states.

**South County Community Services (SCCS) and Vicksburg United Methodist Church (VUMC)** are proud to be partners in bringing this awesome program to the south county area.

### **A BOX FULL OF BLESSINGS!**

The once-a-month Angel Food is available in a quantity that fits into a medium-sized box. **The cost is \$30 for approximately \$60 worth of fresh, frozen and boxed or canned food items. You can order as many monthly boxes as you can use. Each regular box is \$30. The senior box is \$28.**

The food is all the same high quality that you would find in the grocery store. There are no second-hand items, no damaged or outdated goods, no dented or label-less cans, no day-old bread and no produce that is almost too ripe.

In addition to the regular monthly food box, there are special, bonus boxes containing meats, produce and/or holiday meal options. The bonus boxes can only be ordered along with a regular monthly box. Bonus boxes are an additional cost and prices vary.

### **PARTICIPATION IS EASY**

There are no applications to complete. There are no age or household income limits. **Everyone who eats qualifies!** However, there are some "rules" regarding the ordering, payment and pick-up of the monthly food boxes.

### **HOW TO ORDER**

The February 2009 order menu can be picked up at the SCCS office (101 S. Main St., Vicksburg) or the Schoolcraft Community Center (498 Cass St. in Schoolcraft) or at VUMC (217 S. Main St., Vicksburg). It also is on page 9 of this *Sampler*.

**ORDERS MUST BE PLACED IN PERSON AT THE SCCS OFFICE OR AT VUMC. YOU MUST PAY WHEN YOUR ORDER IS PLACED.**

**You can pay by cash or by money order made out to SCCS. You also can pay with food stamps/Bridge Cards. NO CHECKS. NO PHONE ORDERS.**

### **ORDERING DATES & HOURS**

You do not need an appointment to come in to place an Angel Food order, but you do need to come in on the designated ordering dates.
